Holidays and Absences

Although nursery attendance is not statutory, it is important for parents/carers to report their child's absence to nursery on the first day. Nursery has to follow guidelines set out by the local authority regarding the regular attendance of all children. Funding

Please make sure, if eligible, you apply for or renew your working entitlement code for the Autumn term by 31st August. This is to be renewed every 3 months. You can find out more information regarding funding available and tax-free childcare at: https://www.childcarechoices.gov.uk/ and on the parent FAQs leaflet attached from Essex County Council.

Did you know that Oaklea Montessori nursery also offers the Stretched funding for the 50 weeks that Oaklea is open?

As Oaklea Ramsey was the head office for Oaklea Montessori nursery, we have had to update the *Tax-Free childcare information* for the Colchester settings. The postcodes have therefore been updated on the system, which you may need to re-register to make payments, if you have problems then please let us know.

September 2024 – introducing consumable charges:

Unfortunately, the funded hours are significantly lower than our hourly rate and as such do not cover the rising costs of consumables. The Early Years Entitlement funding is intended to deliver free, high quality, flexible childcare. It is **not** intended to pay for the costs of meals, drinks, snacks, other consumables, extra hours or additional activities. We have kept the price low, although will keep under review.

To help the nursery remain sustainable, a consumable charge of £1 per 3-hour core session 9-12pm / 1-4pm or £2 for all day 9-3pm, will be introduced from September 2024. This will be automatically added to your monthly invoice.

Observations and Assessments

For our leavers, we will support their transition to school. They will have fewer observations which will not be linked to EYFS development statements. Thank you for your comments on your child's 'learning journal' report, this will be forwarded onto your child's reception teacher in the next couple of weeks.

Please note that you will need to send the 'learning journal' reports to yourself no later than 6 weeks after your child has left nursery. After this, their records will be unavailable in compliance with GDPR protocols.

Leavers Celebration

Our leavers celebration for our school leavers will take place on **Monday 15th**^h **July 2.15 -3pm** at the local nature garden at the back of the recreation ground, New Town. **This event is just for children who are leaving to start Primary School.** We will also bring the children's bags as many of you like to collect your children and their belongings so that you can leave directly after the celebration. If your child is booked in that afternoon, we will escort them to the nature garden and we will hand them into your care at the end of the celebration. If your child does not attend on Monday afternoons, please bring them to the event and encourage them to sit with their friends for the duration of the event. <u>Please do NOT take photographs,</u> there are some very good reasons why some parents and carers do not wish their child's photograph to be taken! You may want to take photos after the Celebration with your child's friends (if parents agree) and staff members. Please advise us of your child's last day with us. Thank you.

We wish all our school leavers all the best for the next stage of their learning journey, please come back and visit us.

Booking Holiday Sessions

We are open throughout the holidays. If you would like your child to attend, you **must** advise us no later than Friday 28th June 2024 for the Summer holiday, including the hours you require. **So, please think ahead NOW**, as we need to have the correct staff / child ratios! If your child is FEEE funded and would usually have claimed all their hours during term time, these sessions will be chargeable. We will be doing lots of activities to support children who will be starting school in September. As usual we continue to offer Holiday Club and Activity Days for older siblings/after school children. We are hoping to explore our local community more this Summer.

Polite Reminder

Please continue to dress your children ready for the weather and activities that children engage in. Please make sure your child has sun protection applied *before* they arrive at nursery and a named sunhat. Even in the summer, children need to arrive wearing wellies/crocs with easy-to-put-on indoor shoes or slippers in their bags. They also need a change of clothing in their bags and please make sure that all clothing is clearly NAMED.

Illness

Please can we remind all parents to adhere to the following guidelines if your child is poorly (please see notice board for the up-to-date public health guidance). For sickness/diarrhoea children cannot attend until 48 hours after the last bout of illness. Please note, **we cannot issue unprescribed medication**. Additionally, we continue our policy of No Calpol, to reduce the risk of spreading illness – if your child is unwell, please keep them at home where they can rest and recuperate so they can return quickly to explore with their friends and teachers.

Nursery Gate:

Please can you make sure your child, does not climb on the Magdalen Hall gates.

Greeting your child – no MOBILE phones at nursery gate!

Please remember to greet your child each day with a SMILE, NOT A MOBILE. Ask them about their day and tell them about yours, supporting your child's speaking and listening skills.
